The primary school is then the place to refine the already learned in bilingual, inter-year and project-orientated class. Small-sized learning groups ensure that our students succeed. Their advantages compared to other children can be witnessed in many situations.

Miss Anne Fischbach, head of the primary classes and temporary leader of the methodology and didactics department will be in place to answer any further questions.

The acceptance we perceive from the parents ensures a wide word by mouth communication of all those positive results. We also would like to mention a recommendation that lead into another form of support. Out of his overall positive impression of our school, Dr. Walf from the Bosch company promised us help.
